



- **Where are campers staying?**

Campers will be staying in groups at host homes. Group size will vary, but each group will have their own host home that will serve as the place where they sleep and where they do their small group times. The group leaders will stay with them the entire time and all group leaders and adults providing a host home will have a background check on file.

- **Do they need to bring any special equipment/clothing?**

Everything campers will need to bring will be listed on the "Retreat Packet". This packet will be e-mailed to you near the event and also will be available on the Adventure Camp page. (www.pendcc.org/adventurecamp)

- **What should they NOT bring?**

Also listed in the "Retreat Packet" will be any items students should not bring.

- **Are scholarships available to cover the cost?**

Yes. We never want money to be a reason a student doesn't attend an Adventure Camp event. Contact Devin@pendcc.org about a scholarship.

- **Can my child be in the same group as their friend?**

Yes. In fact, the registration asks for you to list two of your child's friends. We want all campers to be excited about hanging out with their friends and growing with God over the weekend.

- **My child takes morning/evening meds. Who will administer these?**

Your child's group leader will make sure they take their medication when needed.

- **My child is allergic to dogs/cats/etc. Can they stay in a pet-free home?**

Absolutely, please list this in your registration or email Devin@pendcc.org if you forgot to include it in your original registration.

- **Have background checks been done on host families?**

Yes. Background checks will be done on all members of the host home families before the event.

- **Can my child's special diet be accommodated?**

Yes. If we plan a head we can work with you to make sure your child's special diet is accommodated. You can e-mail Katrina@pendcc.org with any special dietary needs.

- **Is Winter Weekend only for Pendleton students? Can a friend from another school district apply?**
